




UNTANGLE THE LEASHES

 - o What around you is beautiful?

2. Weather report

- What's the weather like outside? When you go on a walk, make your own "weather report" by answering the following questions:
 - o Is it sunny, cloudy, or a mix of both?
 - o Is it hot or cold? How did the temperature change throughout your walk?
 - o Is it raining or snowing?
 - o Did you enjoy the weather?
 - o How did you prepare to be outside? What should others wear to be comfortable outside today?








WALKIES WALKING CHALLENGE

When you reach the end, cut out and color the badge at the bottom of this page to celebrate finishing the challenge!








YOU'RE A COMIC ARTIST!
